Summer's over, but that doesn't mean you have to give up weekend getaways. Victoria's new Brentwood Bay Lodge & Spa is a lovely spot to check out – and into – in the fall. Set on a pretty treed inlet, the lodge has 33 suites outfitted with king-sized beds draped in Italian linens, each equipped with a fireplace in case the weather gets chilly (although Victoria's average October temperature is a comfortable 14C).

Sybarites can while away the hours with pampering treatments at the spa, where a heated pool, hot tub, aroma garden, still flourishing in autumn, beckon.
